Also, they had some material left over in the spray patch truck, so the owner called me and asked if we had any where he could have his driver spray and patch with it. I sent him down Maple and we got new summer potholes patched for free, which saves WLLA money!

Culvert Bridge over Walker Lake Creek

Not thought of until John's insight, this is a major asset that must be planned for future repair as it a vital ingress and egress of the community and the only access point on the northern end.
